Horses being evaluated are required to be DNA typed & micro-chipped for positive identification. If your horse is not DNA typed or micro-chipped then please order on the next page. No micro-chipping or DNA typing will be done at the Evaluation site.

Coggins: For horse traveling within Canada a Coggins test is not required. A copy of a negative 2009 Coggins test must be received by the Evaluation Co-ordinator post-marked no later than **July 15th, 2010**, for horses traveling from the US to Canada.

Note: For this combined Evaluation we will accept **Canadian Funds** for the fees from all entries.

PLEASE HAVE ALL ENTRIES POSTMARKED BY June 25, 2010

To be eligible for evaluation, a Fjord must:

- be owned by an NFHR or CFHA member,
- be registered with the NFHR or CFHA,
- have been DNA typed,
- be microchipped, and
- have a negative Coggins test if traveling from the US to Canada.

The DNA typing kits and microchips are available from Mike May for NFHR registered horses and he is the person to contact if you have questions regarding your Fjord's status on any of the above five requirements. Mike's phone number is 585-872-4114 and his email is registrar@nfhr.com.

All owners and handlers are responsible for knowing and following the rules as described in the handbook. The handbook may be downloaded FREE from the site, or if you prefer, Mike May can mail you a printed copy for a fee of \$25 US.

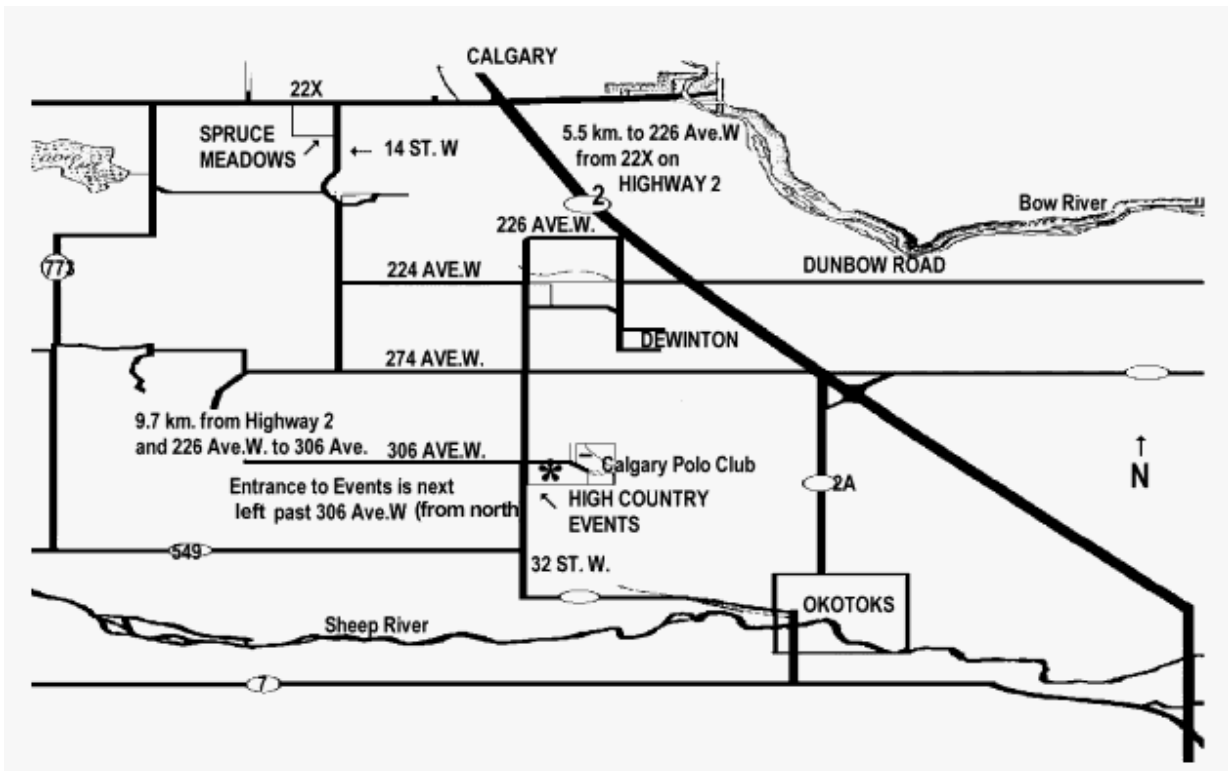
Camping

Camping is available on the Calgary Polo Grounds at a cost of \$25.00 for the event. There is a shower room and porta potties in the area along with a water hydrant. There are no hook ups for the campers.

Stabling

The stabling fee is \$50 for the entire event. Arrive from noon on Wednesday. All stalls will be assigned. Please clean your stalls when leaving. The Calgary Polo Grounds asks that everyone has a stall as they do not want you showing from your trailers.

Location:



From the North: It is best to come south on Hwy 2 (Deerfoot Trail) and then WEST along Hwy 22X toward Spruce Meadows. (Marquis of Lorne Trail) Then take Hwy 2A south (MacLeod Trail) toward Fort Macleod. From Hwy 2A turn west on 226 Ave (teepees on the corner) and this road curves south. Follow to 306 Ave. Turn East on 306 Ave. If stabling / camping in section A, turn into second driveway. If section B, go further east on 306 to driveway marked Ranch House.

From the South: Hwy 2 Turn West towards Okotoks at exit 209. Cross the railway tracks and turn right onto Hwy 7 at the first light. When you get to Okotoks, turn North into town and follow this road through town, across the river and tracks to lights at the Petro-Can and Fas-Gas. Turn West. Follow this road until it curves north and continue north to 306 Ave. Turn East on 306 Ave. If stabling / camping in section A, turn into second driveway. If section B, go further east on 306 to driveway marked Ranch House.

From the South: Hwy 22. At Black Diamond turn East on Hwy 7 to Okotoks. At the lights turn north and follow this road through town, across the river and tracks to lights at the Petro-Can and Fas-Gas. Turn West. Follow this road until it curves north and continue north to 306 Ave. Turn East on 306 Ave. If stabling / camping in section A, turn into second driveway. If section B, go further east on 306 to driveway marked Ranch House.

From the East #1 Best to cut off and go south at Intersection of Hwy 9 / 799 and Transcanada #1. Follow south through Langdon to Hwy 22X. Go west along Hwy 22X toward Spruce Meadows. (Marquis of Lorne Trail) Then take Hwy 2A south (MacLeod Trail) toward Fort Macleod. From Hwy 2A turn west on 226 Ave (teepees on the corner) and this road curves south. Follow to 306 Ave. Turn East on 306 Ave. If stabling / camping in section A, turn into second driveway. If section B, go further east on 306 to driveway marked Ranch House.

Black Diamond

From the West: #1 Hwy Coming toward Calgary, take Hwy 22 South. Follow to Bragg Creek, keep aiming south out of Bragg Creek to "T" intersection. Hwy 22 then turns east. Stay on this road past Spruce Meadows and then go South on Hwy 2A (MacLeod Trail) toward Fort Macleod. From Hwy 2A turn west on 226 Ave (teepees on the corner) and this road curves south. Follow to 306 Ave. Turn East on 306 Ave. If stabling / camping in section A, turn into second driveway. If section B, go further east on 306 to driveway marked Ranch House.
